



Campground Rules

All campers must register at the office. Check in time is 2p.m.. Check out time is 12p.m..

Speed limit within the campground is 7 miles per hour at all times.

Quiet hours are from 10p.m. – 8a.m.. Please be respectful and considerate of other campers.

Smoking is not permitted in any building or structure on the property including Main Office, Pavilion, Restrooms, Laundry Room, and Gazebo. Do not throw cigarette butts on the ground.

Trash must be contained in garbage bags and taken to dumpster. The burning of household trash is not permitted. Trash cans are not permitted at campsites. Do not throw trash or cigarette butts on the ground. Please pick up after yourself and children.

Clotheslines are not permitted. Do not hang clothes or towels from trees or camper. Laundry facilities are located in the pavilion. Tarps are not allowed for any reason.

Children must be supervised at all times, in all areas and all buildings. Use of playground equipment is at your own risk.

Bicycles are allowed on roadways only. No skidding in the gravel. No riding after dark.

Do not empty water, grey or black tanks on the ground.

No mechanical repairs, changing of oil, or lubing of any vehicle is allowed. No use of power tools, generators, or compressors without permission from owners/management.

TV, radio, or stereo should not be heard away from campsite.

Fires are permitted in fire rings, fire pits and designated areas only. Do not use fire rings for trash.

Fireworks are not permitted.

Secure and tie down all personal belongings. You are responsible for damages that cause damage to campground property or other campers' personal property.

Please notify owners/management of any issues with campsite, pavilion, laundry facilities, or restrooms.

Owners/management reserve the right to refuse service or entry to anyone.

Owners/management assumes no responsibility for accidents, injuries or loss/damage to persons or property.

Owners/management reserves the right to change and or modify these rules as circumstances dictate.

Pets must be kept on a leash and supervised at all times. Pick up after them immediately. Dogs cannot be left unattended outside. Excessive barking or aggression will not be tolerated. If your dog becomes aggressive or displays aggressive behavior, you will be asked to leave immediately.

Alcoholic beverages must be kept out of reach of minors at all times. Unattended alcoholic beverages are forbidden.

By agreeing to stay with us, you are acknowledging and agree to follow our Campground Rules and understand that failure to comply with these rules are grounds for immediate termination of stay and no refunds of unused time will be offered.
