



PARK POLICIES

RV POLICIES:

Check In/Check Out:

Check In is at 2 PM EST. Call campground if you will be arriving early to see if your site is available. If site is not available the campers who paid for the site have until 12 PM to vacate the site. Owner/Management will not ask any camper to leave early. If site not available after calling campground to check on status of site, please make other arrangements until 12 PM. Pebble Mountain does not have a waiting area for those campers checking-in early. You do not need to contact campground office when you are checking out. Late check-ins are allowed at any time, please contact campground office for instructions. If you are staying for a month or longer, we require an agreement to be signed. Please contact campground office for details.

Site Changes:

You have been assigned a specific site, if you would like to relocate to a different site please contact office or speak with Owner/Management. Due to reservations and maintenance, moving may not be possible. Please inquire before moving to a different site.

Open Fires:

Open fires are not allowed in the campground. Fires must be in fire pits or designated fire rings. Campers are allowed to use their own personal fire ring or fire pit at campsite.

Parking:

Do not park your car/vehicle, in an adjacent site. Use of more than one site will incur additional charges. Please ask Owner/Management about where to park extra vehicle. Ensure that any vehicle is not blocking the road, so as to ensure that all roads remain clear for campers/visitors to come and go.

Site and Park Navigation:

Please be respectful to your neighbor and other campers and do not walk between or through sites when navigating campground. Please use the road, and designated paths to walk around the campground.

Storage:

Storage is allowed under your camper. Items must be placed neatly under camper and remain neat and tidy for duration of stay. If site becomes cluttered or storage area is not kept neat and tidy you will be asked to clean and tidy up area. Failure to comply will result in the termination of stay.

Washing of camper/vehicle:

Washing camper or vehicle (s) is only permitted with a bucket of water and a sponge. Hose washing is not allowed, as it can make a mess and disturb your neighbors or other campers.

VEHICLE POLICIES:

Speed Limit:

This policy is to keep campers, visitors, and pets safe. The speed limit is 7 MPH. Exceeding the speed limit will result in a warning. Multiple warnings will require Owner/Management to ask you to leave without a refund. Safety is our main priority for our campers and visitors.

Parking:

Each camper registration covers one (1) camper and two (2) vehicles per site. Extra vehicles can be parked in areas designated by Owner/Management. Do not park in middle of the road. Do not park in sites that you didn't register or pay for. Do not block garage or tent areas. Vehicles parked in site that you didn't register or pay for will be asked to move vehicle, if park in a sit that you didn't pay or register for a second time your vehicle will be towed at your expense.

ATV/Motorcycles/Side by Sides:

ATV/Motorcycles/Side by Sides are welcome but may not be used in the park.
ATV/Motorcycles/Side by Sides are to only be used to get to and from your site.

GENERAL PARK POLICIES:

Severe Weather:

In case of severe weather, please seek shelter in the bathrooms or laundry area. We love pets, please bring them with you and do not leave them in your camper during severe weather.

Visitors:

All visitors must depart by 10:00 PM. Visitors may not bring pets. Campers are responsible for ensuring their visitors follow all campground rules. Please inform Owner/Management if you are expecting a visitor so that they can be shown which site you are staying at.

Electrical Use:

Be mindful of your AMP usage in your camper, so that you don't trip your breaker during your stay. Please notify Owner/Management if you have any electrical issues during your stay. Please do not work or try to fix electrical pedestal, please inform Owner/Management of any issues.

Laundry:

The laundry room is open 24/7. Change is available in the office. Please do not leave laundry unattended. We are not responsible for accidents or theft. Please inform Owner/Management of any problems or issues with washer or dryer.

Restrooms/Showers:

Restrooms/Showers are open 24/7 with the exception of when they are being cleaned. Please help keep the restrooms as clean as possible. Children under the age of 15 will need adult supervision in the restroom/showers.

Playground/Dog Run:

Playground and Dog Run open at 8:00 AM and closes at dark. Any children under the age of 15 need to be supervised in these areas and all areas of the campground at all times. Loud music and rough play are not permitted at playground and dog run. Do not leave dog unattended in the dog run. Failure to comply or follow these rules and policies will result in the termination of your stay without a refund.

Quiet Time:

Quiet Time is 10:00 PM until 8:00 AM. Campers playing any loud music, fighting, or arguing outside camper during quiet time will be warned only once and then stay will be terminated without a refund.

Trash/Recycling:

There is a trash dumpster located at the exit of the campground. Please do not place trash on the ground or leave it outside overnight. Wildlife are attracted to left out trash or disposed of food. Please do not dispose of metal, wood, furniture, mattresses, or chemicals in campground dumpster. ONLY household trash is allowed in dumpster. Pebble Mountain Campground currently recycles aluminum cans. There is a trash can by soda machine for aluminum cans, or you can bring the aluminum cans to campground office.

Fireworks/Firearms:

Fireworks are prohibited in the campground. Fireworks that are prohibited include but not limited to: sparklers, smoke bombs, aerials, and firecrackers. Firearms are permitted but must remain locked up in camper/vehicle or remain on person for duration of stay. Camper may not discharge firearm in the campground for the duration of stay.

Repairs:

Repairs to vehicle (s) or camper is not permitted at campground unless done by a mobile mechanic. Owner/Management will be happy to recommend a local Mobile RV or Car Repair Service.

Safety/Emergencies:

Check-In Forms are required for all monthly and over night campers. This information is kept private and only used when a situation comes up such as contacting someone in case of emergency. Pebble Mountain Campground never gives out personal information. No soliciting allowed. If you observe any activity that may be of concern please call 423-257-2120 24 hours a day. If you call 911 please inform Owner/Management so that emergency personnel can be escorted to site.

Cancellation of Stay:

If camper/guest decides to leave early there will be no refunds given for the time not used. RV Site: If camper/guest cancels stay 15 days prior to the date of arrival there will be a \$25 cancellation fee. If camper/guest cancels stay less than 15 days prior to date of arrival, there will be a one (1) night stay cancellation fee. Monthly Stay: If camper/guest cancels more than 15 days prior to date of arrival there will be a \$30 cancellation fee. If camper/guest cancels less than 15 days prior to date of arrival, there will be a one (1) night stay cancellation fee.

PET POLICIES:**Leash:**

Please keep your pets on a leash at all times when outside of camper. This helps every camper and other pets remain safe.

Buildings:

Pets are not allowed in any of the buildings with the exception of service animals. Do not tie your pets to our trees or your camper. Do not leave your pets unattended for any length of time.

Cleaning Up After Pet:

Be a good camper and neighbor and clean up after your pet. Do not let your dog deposit waste (poop) on your site or any other campsite. Failure to clean up after your pet will result in the termination of your stay without a refund.

Leaving Pets Unattended:

Pets can not be left unattended for any length of time in our campground. Do not tie your pet to a tree or camper and leave. Leaving your pet unattended is dangerous to your pet. Many factors such as the weather make it dangerous to leave your pet unattended while you are away from your camper.

Barking:

Excessive barking is not tolerated and it disturbs your neighbors and other campers. Please know that excessive barking may result in the termination of your stay without a refund.
